

Travel Directions

By Car

From the North

Take the M23 southbound (towards Brighton), carry on south on the A23 past turnings to Gatwick, Haywards Heath and Hassocks. Take the turning left off the A23 signposted to Hurstpierpoint. Almost immediately take a left, then take the next right signposted 'Langton Lane'. Carry on Langton Lane for approximately 1 mile and you will see a 'Langton Grange' sign post on the left. Turn into the driveway and immediately on the left you will see the car port with 'The Lodge' entitled above it - please park here.

From the South

Follow the A23 northbound (from Brighton towards London), take the Exit signposted to 'Hurstpierpoint', turn left at the top of the slip road then first right. Follow the road up the hill until you come to a set of traffic lights and turn right (driving over the A23). Langton Lane is a small turning about half a mile on your left. Continue along Langton Lane until you come to the second pond. You will see a sign 'Langton Grange'. Turn into the driveway and immediately on the left you will see the car port with 'The Lodge' entitled above it - please park here.

From the West

Follow the A27 and take the exit on the left to London (A23).
Then follow directions above 'From the South'

From the East

Follow the A27 to the signpost marked London/Brighton (A23) on the left. Then follow directions above 'From the South'

By Train

Hassocks station is only ten minutes away from Langton Lodge by car. There are regular trains to Brighton (10 minutes), Gatwick (20 mins), London Victoria (1 hour).

Eurostar service at London St Pancras International is one hour 30 minutes away by train.

By Air

We are easy to reach by air, whether you are travelling from an international location or within the UK. There are numerous airlines servicing the airports near us.

London Gatwick Airport is only 30 minutes away by car or train.

London Heathrow Airport is approximately one hour and 5 minutes away by car

London Luton Airport is approximately one hour and 30 minutes away by car

London Stansted Airport is approximately one hour and 35 minutes away by car

By Sea

Transmanche Ferries operate from the local ferry port Newhaven, only 35 minutes away by car. They offer regular sailings from Dieppe, France throughout the year. The journey takes 4 hours.

And only 1.5/2 hrs away from major ports of Dover, Portsmouth and Southampton.

By Euro Tunnel

Avoid delays by weather and customs, connects to France, Belgium and beyond.

Euro Tunnel is approximately one hour and 30 minutes away by car. Near Folkestone, take the motorway exit at junction 11A on the M20.
